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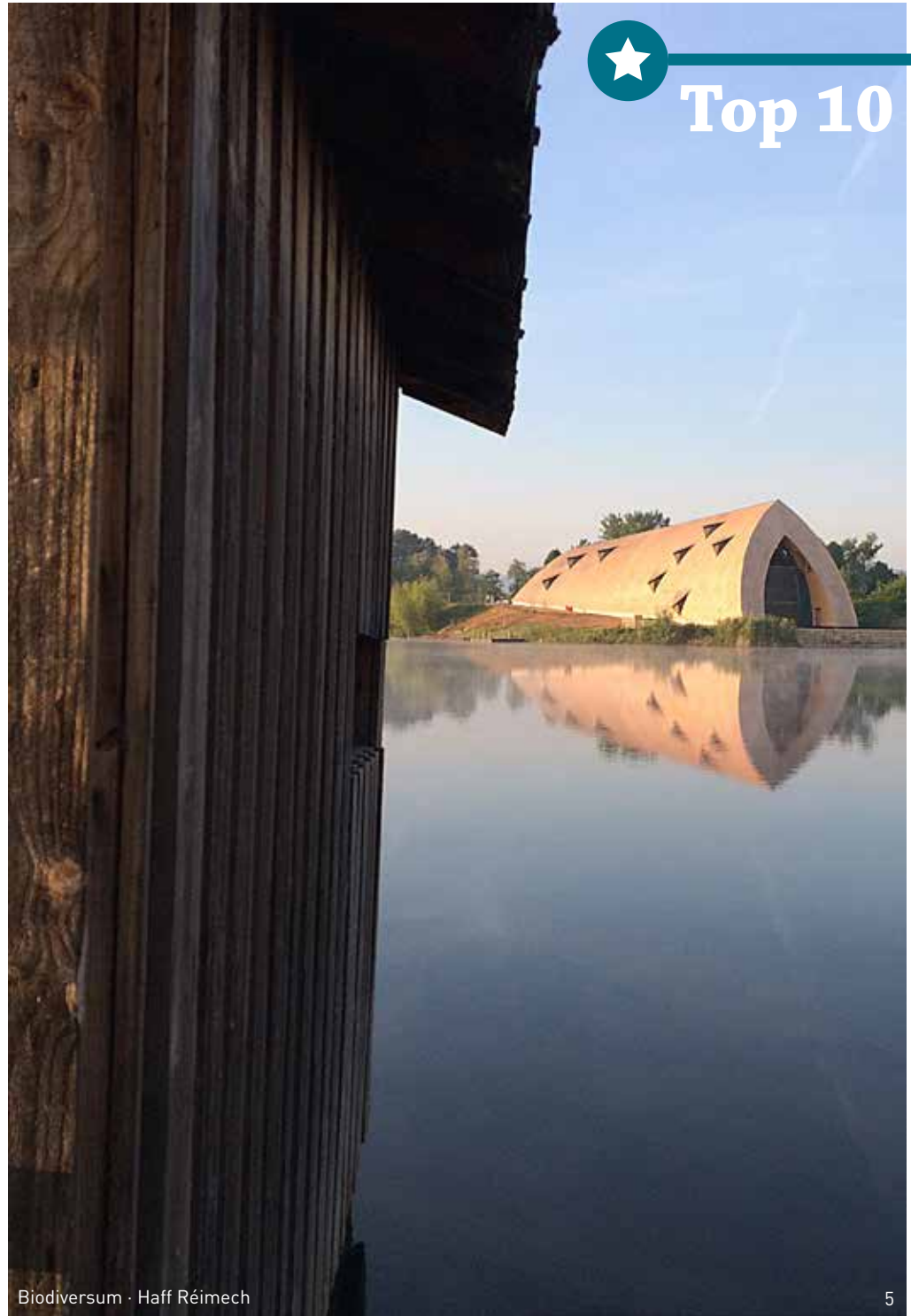

It is not by accident that Schengen, the picturesque wine-making village, situated in the Three Border Region Germany-France-Luxembourg was chosen as the setting for the famous signature of the Schengen Agreement on the 14th June 1985 onboard the ship **M.S. Princesse Marie-Astrid**.

Uniquely situated, Schengen is not only the point of intersection of three countries, but of five, considering the Benelux countries (Luxembourg-Netherlands-Belgium) as an economic union. The fact that the Agreement was signed in Luxembourg shows the important role that the Grand-Duchy played as mediator between its European neighbours.

Crémant de Luxembourg

The appellation "Crémant de Luxembourg" celebrated its 25th anniversary in 2016! Thanks to its finesse, elegance and freshness, Luxembourg Crémant has enjoyed unparalleled success, winning awards every year at international competitions. Crémant is made using a traditional method mastered long ago. As pinnacle of quality, it requires hard work in the vineyard and a rigorous selection of grapes and base wines. The best grape varieties grown on the Luxembourg Moselle are used to produce Crémant. The grapes must be very healthy, nicely ripe and intact until they are pressed. For

150 kg of grapes, a maximum authorised of 100 litres of must can be obtained, which then undergoes initial fermentation in a vat. The second fermentation takes place directly in the bottle. A minimum maturation of nine months on the lees is required. Luxembourg mainly produces Crémant brut. Crémant may be produced from a single grape variety or from a blend of several grapes, as vintage or not. Visit one of our 50 Crémant-producer and enjoy a glass of sparkling Crémant.

## 6. Cycling without borders: 3 Countries, 3 Rivers, 12 Routes

“Cycling without borders” consists of three longer main routes, exclusively along signposted cycle paths, which you may explore one by one, in sections or in combinations. The routes lead through the green river valleys of the Moselle, the Saar and the Sûre on either side of the open national borders. One time rough rocks and impressive forests are the sceneries of the varied tours, another time there

you will cross vineyards and lush meadow orchards, lovely villages or small historic towns. **The three main routes are completed by a total of nine shorter secondary itineraries corresponding to the themes of nature, culture and delight.**

## Nature

The Moselle region is a "Nature" landscape. Both amateur and experienced hikers will be satisfied. Many theme trails will lead you to discover countless species of fauna and flora. Everything is well laid out so that hikers can easily find their way: marked and signposted trails and a labelling system that is precise, informative and easy to understand. Some of the trails have an educational character: a discovery of nature with all the senses for young and old!

### National trails

There are national paths all over the Grand-Duchy of Luxembourg. Two of these trails are situated in the Moselle region. The **Schengen-Hellange trail** (25 km) and the **Moselle trail** (58 km) along the Moselle river.

#### Ahn: Wine and Nature Path Palmberg



This certified hiking trail starts in the wine growing village of Ahn. Hiking alongside limestone rocks you will discover the vineyards of Palmberg with their splendid views of the Moselle valley. After crossing the vineyards, the track will lead you through lush forests towards the nature reserve of Palmberg, famous for its orchids. And finally the trail sneaks alongside the "Donverbach" creek crossing the ravine forest.

### Schengen without borders

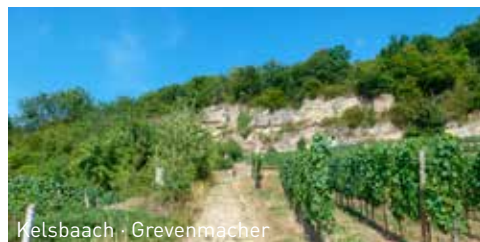


The starting point of the certified hiking trail “Schengen without borders” is near the European Museum in the European village of Schengen, on the borders of the Moselle. At first the track will lead you through the nature reserve of Stromberg, then you will cross the border to France and arrive in the small village of Contz-les-Bains. Up on the heights you will enjoy a fabulous view of the Moselle valley. Due to its geographic location, the “Schengen without borders” trail enables you to discover 3 countries: France, Germany and Luxembourg. Don’t miss out on the European Museum in Schengen.

### Manternach: “Manternacher Fiels”



Large parts of the Moselle Valley are characteristic of the Triassic period. The abundance of shells and corals led to the formation of an enormous layer of lime. It is to that lime area that the dreamlike “Manternacher Fiels” river bend will lead you. Located in the Syr Valley, a 32-kilometre long affluent of the Moselle River, the Township of Manternach was in the past an important place for the paper and steel industry. The track will lead you through the vineyards of the nature reserve to the ancient orchards on the Lellig Plateau. Historic mills, ravines and superb vistas will accompany you all along the trail, together with the truly impressive richness of its explanatory panels.

This easy circular hiking trail gives us an idea of the development, diversity and exploitation of woods, so that we get to know and learn to protect the wood and its flora and fauna, because only an intact nature provides a healthy quality of life while increasing our well-being. ### Wasserbillig: Cultural walk

At 17 stations with a total of 30 stylishly designed information signs, the visitor can learn all about the culture, history and natural landscapes of Wasserbillig. A small loop (3,3 km) leads to the culturally and historically important sites of the village, a large loop (9,9 km) takes you out into the open countryside with stunning views over the valleys of the Moselle and Sauer.

### Wellenstein: Circuit Crémant

The walking trail starts in Wellenstein, a lovely little winegrowers’ village nestled on the slopes of the Moselle Valley, which has made its cultural heritage available to its many visitors. During your trip you will pass the “Cave Coopérative de Wellenstein”, that represents nowadays one of the largest vineyards in Luxembourg.

## Nature reserves



### “Haff Réimech”



Luxembourg’s largest wetland lies between the Moselle and the vineyards, on the grounds of a former gravel mining site. Two learning paths with several roofed observation points allow visitors to discover the area’s unique diversity, which offers a perfect natural habitat to a wide range of bird species.

### “Manternacher Fiels”



The “Manternacher Fiels” is both a national and a European protected area. The heart is the ravine forest, which covers around 57 hectares and presents the largest in Luxembourg. It has not been managed for more than 50 years. Human interventions in the forest area are restricted to the free and open spaces of the hiking trails. Since 2012 the Manternacher Fiels is officially a natural forest reserve.

### Discovery path “Stroumbierg”

This former plaster mining site now holds a natural conservation area. It is home to a range of protected plant species and a rich wildlife. The learning path is duly signalled and starts under the bridge in Schengen.

### “Kuebendällchen”

This 35-ha-large area, situated around the village of Wintrange, has been marked by various modes of exploitation throughout history. While the north-western flank of the valley has been used for forestry since ancient times, the south-eastern slopes were used by small impoverished farmers as vineyards and pastureland.

### Natural Forest Reserve “Grouf”

This 153 ha large natural conservation area fitted with a nature guided path provides a unique insight into the local ecosystem. In these zones covered by beech and oak trees the emphasis lies on natural conservation and renewal, which means that the area is left to develop naturally, i.e. without human intervention. Visitors will find a general information board at the “entrance” of the area, while most interesting locations along the 7,2 km long nature path are listed on a special leaflet available at the municipal administration from Schengen in Remerschen and the Tourist Information Centre in Schengen.

The circular path, which starts in Schengen (under the Moselle bridge towards the German town of Perl), is signalled by an orange-coloured symbol representing a stag beetle on a green background.

The mediterranean garden in Schwebsange belongs to the Luxembourg nature protection foundation natur&ëmwelt – Fondation Hëllef fir d’Natur. The foundation has taken over the garden as part of a gift from Charles Roovers and Dieter Lingener in 2009. Today, the garden counts 1.500 m<sup>2</sup> and is cultivated according to biological and ecological criteria. It gives shelter to a large number of mediterranean and tub plants, as well as to the classic and rare ones.

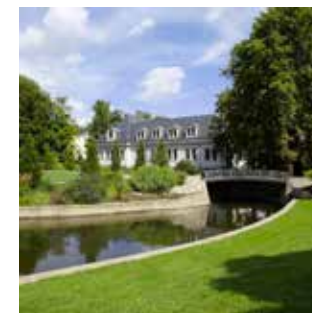

## Canoeing in the Moselle Region



Canoeing is an active leisure pursuit that can be enjoyed by anyone – young or old, couples or groups - everyone gets their money's worth in Miselerland! A canoe route from Schengen to Wasserbillig with some signposted stopping points along the way makes cross-border access to the River Moselle easier.

A canoe trip through the Moselle valley also involves gliding rapidly through a time lapse of more than 200 million years of the Earth's history.

The Romans were already rowing on the Moselle, enthusing about the many different Moselle wines, the production of which has been developed into an accomplished art by our present-day wine growers. Canoeists can decide for themselves at which wine growing spot they wish to end their journey in order to enjoy award-winning wines and sparkling Crémants, or maybe also enjoy a trip to a wine cellar as the perfect finale to the canoe trip!

Canoeists can also explore natural tributary valleys on foot along their route, visit interesting museums or simply enjoy paddling and being swayed gently by passing freight vessels.

Once a varied river course with lots of islands and rapids, the Moselle has been developed into a



navigable inland waterway since 1964 and its course has been regulated by barrages and lock systems. The current has become more sedate and locks for leisure boats allow you to pass from one area to the next from 1st April to 31st October.

Please note that there are no rental stations for canoes in the Moselle region at the moment.

## Wines and Crémants



Over the 42 km that the Moselle travels from Schengen to Wasserbillig, it has sculpted a hilly landscape, cut out of limestone, representing an ideal birthplace for viticulture.

Situated on the north slope of the river, the vineyards are for the most part between 300 and 400 metres wide, of which more than half (especially in the canton of Remich) consists of deep soils, mixing gypsum and marl for a full-bodied and smooth wine and Crémants. Fissured layers of shell limestone predominate in the Canton of Grevenmacher, where racy and elegant wines are perfectly at home.

The Riesling is the "king of wines" of the Luxembourg Moselle. It's a wine of great class and eminent roots. Its fruity bouquet and long-lasting taste make it an ideal companion for fish.



### Rivaner

It's a fruity wine with charming bouquet. It never disappoints of any time of the day. It's a convivial wine and is very suitable for the aperitif.



### Pinot Noir

Totally fine and fresh, its seduction overwhelms as soon as the bottle of Rosé is presented to you. The special character of the wine is brought out particularly by a "calf's sweetbread medallion" or by an "Osso buco".



### Pinot Blanc

This Wine has a quite delicate freshness and permits the subtlety of many mixed "hors d'oeuvres" or "selection of cold cuts". It goes excellently with various fish dishes.



### Pinot Gris

This excellent wine maintains beneath its semi-dry character a finely spiced robustness which never fails to seduce the enthusiast. It is recommended to fine and taste-rich meals.

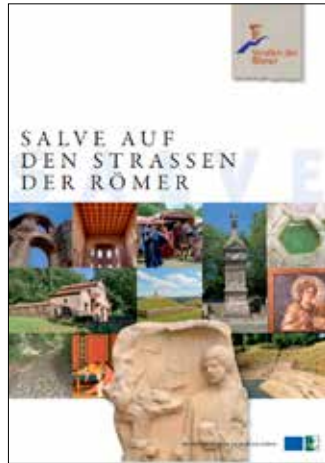

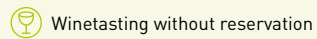
